CONNECTICUT NETWORK MOVES TO CHANNEL 98 IN COMCAST HARTFORD, VERNON AND PLAINVILLE FRANCHISES

Hartford, CT – Effective Wednesday, December 10, the Connecticut Network will be moved to channel 98 in Comcast’s Hartford, Vernon and Plainville franchises. This includes the towns of Andover, Avon, Berlin, Bloomfield, Bolton, Bristol, Burlington, Canton, East Hartford, Ellington, Farmington, Hartford, Hebron, Marlborough, New Britain, Plainville, Simsbury, Tolland, Vernon, West Hartford and Windsor.

The move is part of an overall channel realignment placing CT-N next to C-SPAN on these systems’ channel lineup. The network remains part of Comcast’s basic service package in these areas and all other CT-N channel numbers remain the same statewide.

Winner of the 2007 Helen M. Loy Freedom of Information Award and national Sunshine Award from the Society of Professional Journalists, Connecticut Network is the state’s source for complete and balanced television and webcast coverage of state government and public affairs.
