Connecticut Network to Air Memorial Reception for Speaker Irving Stolberg

Hartford, CT – The Connecticut Network will be broadcasting the Memorial Reception for Former Speaker of the House Irving Stolberg. The service will be held Tuesday at 5:00 PM in the Legislative Office Building Atrium. Air times for both the premiere and rebroadcasts will be posted on www.ct-n.com.

Irving Stolberg, a Democrat, served in the House of Representatives for 22 years and was Speaker of the House twice during that time. Among his many achievements, he is known for overseeing the construction of the Legislative Office Building and changing tax policies in Connecticut. As well as being on most of the committees in the General Assembly, he served as Chairman for the following committees: Human Services, Intern, Legislative Management and Finance. He was President and Board Member of the Connecticut Division of the United Nations Association. Stolberg died after of leukemia on February 13, 2009.
